Type of Camp: Dental Screening and Treatment Camp


Date: 6th March 2011

To mark this day in the field of dentistry, "Dentist Day" is celebrated worldwide.

M S Ramaiah Dental College and Hospital, Department of Public Health Dentistry in association with Sarvothra Community Development center, organised a special dental screening and treatment camp held at Government School Anekal village. In addition to it, Oral Health Education was aimed at some of the common oral health problems like dental caries, periodontal diseases and risk factors associated with oral cancer was also addressed. The entire programme was sponsored by M S Ramaiah Dental College and Hospital. All those individuals requiring level 2 and level 3 treatments were referred to M S Ramaiah Dental College and Hospital for further care. A total of 140 individuals were examined, 47 patients with varies dental problems were treated (Extraction, Restoration and oral prophylaxis) in our mobile dental van. Patients with special care were referred back to the institution for comprehensive care. The villagers were very complacent at our services and promised to participate better in the coming dental screening and treatment programmes.
